## Norton Internet Security 2003/2004

**Abstract:** *This article describes how to allow a local network connection used by ActiveClient that is sometimes blocked by Norton Internet Security. These changes do not compromise the external security of your system.*

Manually configuring Norton Internet Security or Norton Personal Firewall for your network:

1. Open the Norton Internet Security or Norton Personal Firewall
2. In the main program window, double-click Personal Firewall
3. On the Networking tab, in the Trusted tab, click Add
4. Type the IP address '**127.0.0.1**' into the box.
5. Click OK. The address that you entered appear on the Trusted tab.
6. Click OK.
